

HOW YOUR RESIDENTIAL WATER IS BILLED:

Example using **under 5,000** gallons of water: **Quantity Billed: 3,500 gallons**
Base Amount: \$5.14
Usage Calculation: $3,500/1,000 = 3.5 \times \$2.85 = \$9.97$
Amount billed for water only: \$15.11 (\$5.14 + \$9.97)

Example using **under 15,000** gallons of water: **Quantity Billed: 12,200 gallons**
Base Amount: \$5.14
Usage Calculations: first $5,000/1,000 = 5.0 \times \$2.85 = \$14.25$
remaining $7,200/1,000 = 7.20 \times \$3.58 = \$25.77$
Amount billed for water only: \$45.16 (\$5.14 + \$14.25 + \$25.77)

Example using **over 15,000** gallons of water: **Quantity Billed: 29,390 gallons**
Base Amount: \$5.14
Usage Calculations: first $5,000/1,000 = 5.0 \times \$2.85 = \$14.25$
next $10,000/1,000 = 10.0 \times \$3.58 = \$35.80$
remaining $14,390/1,000 = 15.11 \times \$4.47 = \$64.33$
Amount billed for water only: \$119.52 (\$5.14 + \$14.25 + \$35.80 + \$67.54)

HOW YOUR RESIDENTIAL SEWER IS BILLED:

Residents with **no** established water history, the 3 full recalculation month's billings (the December, January & February, established after November 15, 2024, that we base our sewer rates on), are billed a **flat monthly rate of \$60.29**.

Residents with established water history (the 3 full recalculation month's billings - December, January & February) are based on the actual water usage average for these months. You are billed at that same sewer rate each month until recalculated again in March of each year.

Example of how sewer is calculated once established water history:

*December usage 2,410 gallons, January usage 1,690 gallons & February usage 760 gallons = 4,860 gallons, divided by 3 = 1,620 gallons average, multiplied by $\$9.45/1,000 = \$15.30 + \$17.76$ base charge = \$33.06 sewer charge each month.
