

The City of Otsego Department of Building Safety **requires** permits for the following:

- Lawn Irrigation
- Decks
- Basement Finishing
- Plumbing
- Siding / Roofing / Window or Door Replacement
- Mechanical / HVAC
  - Air Conditioner
  - Furnace
  - Gas Line

Administration permits **required** for: Fences, Fowl, and Housing Rentals

## PERMITS NOT REQUIRED

- Decks or platforms not more than 30" above adjacent grade and NOT attached to a structure with frost footings and which is not part of an accessible route
- Detached 1-story structures not exceeding 200 square feet, i.e., a small shed. You still have to stay within your yard's easements (if you don't have a copy of your lot survey, the City may be able to provide you with one)
- Painting, papering, tiling, carpeting, cabinets, countertops, and similar finish work
- Retaining walls not exceeding 4 feet in height
- Prefabricated swimming pools 24" or less in depth, do not exceed 5,000 gallons and are installed entirely above ground
- Window awnings



## MUNICIPAL WATER

### Water Facilities

The City maintains 4 well houses - 10 wells and 4 water towers.

### Water Distribution

The distribution system consists of 100 miles of watermain, 1,100 hydrants, 2,300 isolation valves and several pressure control stations. The City flushes the hydrants in the spring and fall to clean supply lines and to inspect and operate system components.

### Irrigation Restrictions (May 1 - September 30)

These restrictions include an odd-even schedule and midday ban. Watering from 11am - 5pm is prohibited **on all days**. Addresses ending in an odd number may irrigate on odd numbered calendar days. Addresses ending in an even number may irrigate on even numbered calendar days.

Did you know more than 60% of all water used at your home is used during just four summer months?


