

Paddle Port Rental Rules

- In the event of an emergency, dial 911. The location of this I Paddle Port system is **Norin Landing Park** (10599 Kadler Avenue NE, Otsego, MN 55330). The return station is located at **Carrick's Landing Park** (9050 Quantrelle Avenue NE, Otsego, MN 55330).
- Lifejackets (PFD) save lives. Always fit the PFD correctly and wear at all times.
- **Doors must be opened 5 minutes before the end of your scheduled rental timeframe.**
- Paddle at your own risk. Be vigilant of weather, water levels, and other environmental risks.
- Please respect the equipment. Damaged equipment due to neglect may result in additional fees.
- Please report any missing or damaged equipment to (763) 235-3148.

Important Information

- Reservations can be made 21 days in advance and you can reserve more than one boat at a time. Refunds must be submitted 72 hours prior to that start of reservation.
- All rentals need to be returned by 4:55 pm or they are subject to a \$100 late fee!
- Tell a friend or family that you are going kayaking and let them know when you plan to return.
 - Follow the 4 W's
 - Where you're going?
 - Who you're going with?
 - When will you return?
 - What to do if you don't return?
- This paddle share system is for experienced kayakers. You must be 18 years or older to operate a kayak by yourself. You can be younger or be less experienced if you are in a two-person kayak with an experienced adult kayaker.
- The system will be shut down due to unfavorable conditions. (High water levels/currents, heavy precipitation, strong winds forecasted) no later than one hour before rental periods. To have your reservation fee refunded, please fill out and submit a refund form on the I Paddle Port website within 48 hours of your reservation being cancelled. The conditions for a refund are listed in the Reason for Request section at the bottom of the form. Check the City website, Facebook or call (763) 235-3148 to confirm station is open.
- Be aware of hazards on the river like fallen trees, rocks, stumps and other obstructions as well as piers and eddies.
