## THE OTSEGO HERITAGE PRESERVATION COMMISSION

The Otsego Heritage Preservation Commission was established by a City Ordinance on June 27, 1994 to:

- Safeguard the heritage of the City by preserving sites and structures which reflect elements of the City's cultural, social, economic, political, visual or architectural history;
- Promote the preservation and continued use of historic sites and structures for the education and general welfare of the people of the City;
- Foster civic pride in the beauty and notable accomplishments of the past; and
- Stabilize and improve City property values.

Efforts to document and provide access to cemetery records, as contained in this book, are in direct response to the purposes noted above. Other activities of the Otsego Heritage Preservation Commission include:

- Developing a comprehensive plan for historic preservation to assist in the identification, registration, and protection of architectural and archaeological properties as well as significant cultural landscape features;
- Recording oral history interviews with members of families who have resided in Otsego since its early days;
- Publishing information regarding the Commission's activities and the history of Otsego;
- Organizing an annual Otsego Heritage Day;
- Organizing and making available documents, photographs and related materials on the history of Otsego for access by all interested parties;
- Contributing to knowledge in the community about Otsego's history by distributing its brochure and other publications to local schools and libraries, and maintaining a display case of historical materials at City Hall; and
- Examining the feasibility of restoration and use of various structures and sites in Otsego deemed to be historic, and applying for historic designations as appropriate.

## THE OTSEGO CEMETERY

The Otsego Cemetery is a treasured historical site. There is evidence that it was used as early as 1854. The oldest graves were identified by sight inspection.

- <> Charlie Pippin - died October 28, 1854 - age 1 year 6 months
- <> Charlie L. Pippin - died February 8, 1861 - age 4 years 10 months 6 days  
A single monument marks these two graves. It is inscribed "Suffer the little children to come to me and forbid them not for of such is the Kingdom of God" "Children of J & J Pippin"
- <> Albert E. Porter - died February 13, 1858 - age 6 years
- <> Juliatt Porter - died April 10, 1864 - age 18 years  
The epitaph on their monument reads "Children of S & M J"
- <> Julia LaPlant - died January 31, 1861 - age 4 years 3 months 15 days  
Her gravestone identifies her as "Daughter of C & E LaPlant"
- <> Charles B. Cooley - died February 9, 1861 - age 3 years 3 months
- <> Emma F. Cooley died January 31, 1864 - age 2 years 5 months 12 days  
Their monument is engraved "Children of A L & M Cooley"

Charlie L. Pippin, Julia E. LaPlant and Charles B. Cooley all died within a ten day period in 1861. All were young children. They may have been victims of some contagious childhood disease such as Scarlet Fever or Diphtheria. These families lived very near on another and the LaPlants and Pippins were related to each other. Later township records of deaths reveal evidence of epidemics; a series of deaths within a short time - all attributed to the same communicable disease.

The families bereaved by the above deaths:

John Baptiste Pepin (often spelled Pippin in early records), his wife Julia (Osier) and children John and Priscilla, came to Otsego in 1854 with Charles LaPlant, his wife Elizabeth (Osier) and children Oliver and Mary. Julia and Elizabeth were sisters of Lewis Osier who had established a trading post in Otsego.

Alvah Landers Cooley, his wife Margaret (Faulkner) and children Burton, Sidney, Ellen Viola and Ada Marie came to Otsego in 1853, only a year after the first permanent settler, John McDonald.

Seneca Porter and his wife Mary Jane arrived in Otsego in 1855 with their children Juliatt, Jane, Alice, Albert and Ellen.





The cemetery is owned by the City of Otsego. It is non-denominational and gravesites can be purchased only by residents of Otsego. Cemetery business and administration is handled by an unpaid volunteer board of directors identified as the "Otsego Cemetery Association". The earliest record found naming members of the board is in minutes of a meeting held May 28, 1927. Jean Vail, S. A. Holt and Nellie Pepin are designated "Directors". The following changes in personnel are recorded in subsequent meeting notes:

- 1978 William Bell transferred the presidency to Harlan Rask and remained a Director. Eugene Kreuser was elected to replace Andy Davis, Jr.
- 1991 William Bell died December 28.

On the following page is a copy of the minutes of early meetings of the board.

A meeting was held in the Town Hall May 7, 1945 to elect officers for the Otsego Cemetery Association. Twelve voters were present.

Guy LaPlant was elected president.  
 Mamie Thomas was elected Sec. Treas.  
 Sid Mosman, Lewis Davis + Lee Vails were elected as directors.

Cemetery Association had a meeting at Roy Spencers May 24, 1945. Ten members were present. Alfred King was unanimously elected to mow the cemetery lawn @ 45¢ per hour.

Lewis Davis has offered to see the town board about cemetery fee.

The cemetery covers approximately four acres. About two acres on the east side in section 16 were acquired by Otsego Township for \$20.00 from Alvah Cooley. The deed is recorded in Wright county March 25, 1867. To date, we have been unable to locate a record of acquiring the land on the west side. A search of old records at the courthouse in Buffalo was unsuccessful. Many of the old records on microfilm are impossible to read.

The copy of a very old map of the cemetery on the following page has a catalog of early owners of lots in the margin surrounding the map itself. (Note: This differs from most maps. Directions are reversed; north is at the bottom; south at the top)

A narrow strip of land containing blocks number 50, 100, 57, 101, 58, 102 and 71 appears to have been added as a result of a change in the road. A copy of the handwritten transfer of that strip from O. J. Tillisch to the Otsego Cemetery follows the map.



## TRANSFER OF LAND

to WHOM it may concern

On this date Sept. 26, 1949, I the undersigned Oscar J. Tillisch do solemnly swear that I am the ~~owner~~ <sup>owner</sup> of the tract of land bordering on the south side of the Otsego Cemetery, extending from the main gate to the west end of <sup>the</sup> Cemetery and extending south to the County Road, which runs parallel with the Cemetery. This parcel of land is in the form of a (U) with the small end at the Cemetery Gate.

On this date, Sept. 26, 1949, upon my word & Honor, I the undersigned, Oscar J. Tillisch, give the above described parcel of land, to the Otsego Cemetery to have for all time to come and that it is to always be used for Cemetery purposes, also that there never will ~~be~~ be trouble or confusion pertaining to this land transaction in the years to come.

Early sales were apparently "by the lot". Land in the cemetery is sectioned in numbered blocks, most of which measure 36 by 36 feet. Each block contains four lots, measuring 18 by 18 feet. Some lots contain as many as six graves. Blocks are separated by three foot wide alleys.

The earliest record of payments is a book covering the period from June 18, 1924 through 1933. Many individuals paid \$2.00 and \$3.00 "dues" and Otsego Township paid \$50.00 a year. Minutes of the April 3, 1953 meeting confirm the amounts charged for "dues".

### Cemetery Meeting 1953

Meeting announcement was carried in Star News for one issue, which was entered by the Secretary, Treasurer Meeting was held at Town Hall, Apr. 3, 1953 at 9:00 P.M. and called and presided over by President, Guy LaPlant. Only four people being present.

All old Officers will hold over for an indefinite period and who are at present time -

The following method of collecting dues for the Cemetery was brought up and O.K.'d and take effect at once, and the method is as follows: -

Owner of  $\frac{1}{2}$  lot will pay \$3.00 per yr.

Owner of 1 lot " " \$3.00 per yr.

Owner of  $1\frac{1}{2}$  lots " " \$4.00 per yr.

Owner of 2 lots " " \$5.00 per yr.

Owner of  $2\frac{1}{2}$  lots " " \$6.00 per yr.

Owner of 1 block (4 lots) " " \$7.00 per yr.

This notice changed the method of charging for gravesites:

## NOTICE

*Effective as of January 1, 1964, the Otsego Cemetery will be run on a Perpetual Care Basis as follows:*

Each New Lot Will Be        \$50.00

Each New Grave Entered      \$40.00

All people paying dues will continue to do so until first burial takes place, then they go into perpetual care.

Anyone wishing to make a settlement in a lump sum may do so.

Dues payments for old graves continued through 1972. In 1973 the board decided to discontinue annual dues and sent letters requesting \$25.00 per grave as final settlement for perpetual care. There are records of \$65.00 payments for gravesites from 1973 through Feb. 1978. From Oct. 18, 1978 through 1981 there are payments of \$125.00. The price of \$150.00 per gravesite plus \$75.00 for perpetual care was in effect from July 1982 to December 1992. In 1993 the price was increased to \$350.00 per site plus \$100.00 for perpetual care.

## SWALLOWED UP BY THE MISSISSIPPI

M. E. Spencer and Son "Freddy"  
Drowned Last Wednesday.

The community was thunderstruck last Thursday by the intelligence rapidly spread about town that Martin E. Spencer, the well known Otsego merchant, and his son "Freddy" were drowned in the Mississippi river the night before, and the report was later fully confirmed. It appears that Martin and his son departed from home about six o'clock in a small boat to gather up some timbers with boom chains attached to them that were coming down the river, expecting to get back home before dark. They never came back, and the truth of how they were drowned will never be known. Mr. Spencer was known as an expert swimmer, and the generally accepted theory is that he perished trying to save his boy. Searching parties were on the river all the next day, but the only trace of the victims found was the hat of Martin floating down the river. Mr. Spencer was postmaster of Otsego for a good many years, and was generally known on both sides of the river and esteemed for many good qualities. He was an old soldier and member of Rogers Post, G. A. R. of Elk River, serving one year as commander. The boy was about fifteen years of age and was attending the Elk River schools, being bright and popular.

April 30, 1896

It was reported last night that Mrs. Belinda Spencer of Otsego, was not expected to live through the night. She fell and broke her hip last spring and has never recovered from the accident. She was the mother of Martin and Charles Spencer, and was 82 years old.

November 5, 1891

The remains of Martin E. Spencer whose drowning was reported in these columns two weeks ago, were found near Anoka last Thursday. The body was found floating among a lot of logs by some boys who were fishing, and having been in the water two weeks was in bad condition. The body was brought home and Friday morning was buried under the auspices of Rogers Post, G. A. R. of which order he was formerly commander. Saturday the body of his son Freeman was recovered from the river just above Minneapolis, and now the remains of both father and son lie side by side in the Otsego cemetery.

The funeral services of Martin E. Spencer and son will be held at the Otsego church next Sunday at 11 o'clock a. m., Rogers Post, G. A. R., attending in a body.

May 14, 1896

The funeral of Mrs. Belinda Spencer, whose death was reported in last week's paper, occurred from the residence of her son, Martin Spencer, on Friday afternoon, and was largely attended by old friends of the deceased. The family wish to extend their thanks to the many kind friends who rendered them assistance during their affliction.

## Accident Fatal to Otsego Boy

Clifton Holt Shot and Instantly Killed at Otsego Last Sunday Morning

A most distressing accident occurred Sunday morning at Otsego when young Clifton Holt, son of Mr. and Mrs. Will Holt, was shot and instantly killed.

Clifton and several companions had gone out hunting during the morning, and while returning they all got to fooling with their guns, and shooting matches at one another, all believing that the guns were unloaded. While one of the other boys had Clifton's gun, he pulled the trigger, still believing it was unloaded.

But Clifton must have put a shell in the gun before handing it to his companion, as it was discharged and hit the young lad in the head, and he dropped dead in his tracks.

Clifton Holt was not quite sixteen years of age and had always lived at Otsego. Besides his parents he is survived by two brothers. He was a student in the eighth grade in the Elk River schools, and was a popular boy, his death causing great sorrow among his classmates. The members of the eighth grade all attended the funeral.

The funeral was held Tuesday from the home, Rev. Adair, of the Otsego church, officiating, and the remains were laid at rest at Otsego cemetery. The funeral offerings were very plentiful and especially beautiful.

## Special Village Election Called

Bonds Must be Voted to Re Issue Old Bridge Bonds Which Mature Soon

Attention is called to the matter for a special village election appearing in this issue, to vote in the sum of \$7,500 to the State of Minnesota. These bonds are the purpose of refunding the bonds used to aid in the building the bridge across the Mississippi river, at this place, which matures next July.

Unless the old bonds are refunded now, the state auditor must, under the law, make a levy sufficient to pay the whole sum of \$7,500 interest this coming year, which would work a great hardship on the tax payers. The present council proposes to have the bonds issued as to pay \$500 each year beginning in the year 1920. In doing that way these bonds will be paid without serious inconvenience to anyone.

Owing to the large expense on the two bridges in Elk River the last two or three years has not been possible to pay off the old bridge bonds.

The high school football team journeyed to Princeton last day and added the Millers County metropolis to a part of their athletic laurels. When the game was over the team returned to Elk River with the game.

## LEONARD SNOW DEAD

Leonard Snow, one of the old residents of this section, died suddenly, at the home of his sister, Mrs. E. Barrows, last Thursday, aged 75 years. Heart trouble was the cause of his death.

Mr. Snow was born in Maine and came to Minnesota in 1856. He enlisted in the First Minnesota and served until discharged for deafness. He was wounded during the war and drew a large pension. The funeral was held Saturday from the Barrows residence and interment was at Vernon cemetery.

## Veteran-Pioneer Called by Death

Taps Are Sounded for Chas. Spencer, Resident of Otsego Since 1853

Another of Otsego's old settlers and a veteran of the Civil War has passed away. Mr. Chas. Spencer died at his home Saturday night. Mr. Spencer was 73 years old and was born in Maine. He came to Otsego in 1853 and always made his home there. He served his country during the 4 years of the war, and was captured and confined in Andersonville prison 9 months.

## RESTORATION PROJECTS

In 1989 a group of dedicated volunteers raised funds and made major improvements. A new chain-link fence now surrounds the site and a beautiful wrought iron gate welcomes visitors. The driveway was extended and an abandoned well was sealed. Local organizations made generous contributions to the project:

Numerous smaller contributions were made by interested individuals.

During the summer of 1996, the Otsego Heritage Preservation Commission started a project to provide an accurate and permanent record of the graves. A site inspection was needed to identify graves not listed on any written records. A new map was necessary to identify locations of graves by block and lot numbers. Peter Rognli of Boy Scout Troop 90 was looking for a community service project to work on. After learning what was needed he volunteered to help. He recruited a group of Boy Scouts:

Frank Anderson, Aaron Arstein, Eric Arstein, Dan Bauer, Chris Behnecke, Jeff Bratz, Mike Hurley, Chad Schumacher, Brent Steuve and Wade Will from Elk River and Peter Lantto, Charles Rodby, Mike Rosenow, Rick Stack and Chris Womson from Otsego. Donna Bratz, Elk River and Jacquie Rognli, Otsego served as adult on-site supervisors. Many hours of work were completed during some hot summer weather.

These volunteers located the corner markers for the numbered blocks - most of these were overgrown with grass. Temporary flags were placed to mark the blocks and alleys. A new map was drawn. In addition, they listed all visible names in every block. They cleaned up overgrown brush, pruned some trees, straightened some leaning monuments and uncovered some stones overgrown with grass.

Inscriptions on gravestones were read and recorded by Jacquie Rognli and Elaine Norin. In many cases they were so old and worn that only a few words could be read.

The result of this research and these projects is the following list of over 450 identifiable graves and a map to show their locations.

VETERANS' GRAVES - The following graves of veterans have been identified. Many others from Otsego are buried elsewhere.





# OTSEGO CEMETERY

## GRAVES IN THE OTSEGO CEMETERY

The following list is alphabetized for easy reference. Information included here was derived from sight inspection of the cemetery, old books of records and the Otsego Township Register of Deaths records for the years 1871 to 1914.

Facts are shown just as they appear on the source document where words and names are often misspelled. For some there is very little information available; for others, very complete facts were found. Where handwritten records, or inscriptions on stones were not legible, material is shown: ?, 1884?, r ?, etc.

The first column contains the name. Next is the block and lot number which identifies the location on the map. The date and place of birth follows the abbreviation "b"; the date and place of death follows "d". The last column contains additional information. Epitaphs are enclosed by " ". Age at death is often shown as the number of years "y", months "m" and days "d". Parents' names and places of birth, occupation of the deceased, marital status (married, widow, etc.), cause of death, name and location of attending physician and name and location of the undertaker/funeral director/mortician are included when known. Names of cities in Minnesota do not include "MN". Many "place of death" entries show Elk River. It is possible that some of these should be Otsego. The post office address was often used instead of the Township location.

In some cases there is a written record of burial, but no marker has been found. If known, the block and lot number is indicated. It is possible that these may have been wood which deteriorated, or some stones may have broken up or were lost to vandalism. Some stones, overgrown with grass or shrubs may still be hidden.

## DEATH RECORDS Otsego Township 1871 to 1914

A wealth of historical information is found in two Otsego Township books titled "Register of Deaths"; one for the period from 1871 to 1901, the other from 1900 to 1914. Information from these books has been incorporated with the cemetery records for those whose gravesites have been identified in Otsego.

These books list names in chronological order by dates of death and the cause of death is given in most cases. These lists reveal a great deal of information about health problems in earlier times. The large number of deaths of children from infectious diseases is tragic. The following examples are typical:

- 1873 3 children in one family, ages 3, 10 and 13 died of Scarlet Fever within 3 months.
- 1877 A family lost 2 children, ages 4 and 6 from Typhoid Fever within 3 days.
- 1883 Diptheria claimed 3 children, ages 5, 8 and 14 between December 10 and 26. What a sad Christmas season.
- 1884 Another family lost children ages 1 and 4 within 2 weeks, from Diptheria.
- 1892 2 children in one family, ages 1 and 8 were lost to Scarlet Fever within 2 months.

It is possible that many more deaths might be attributed to specific diseases; however, many causes of death are recorded in general terms such as "Fever", "Croup", etc.

An alarming number of children failed to survive a year. Of the 281 deaths listed 72 (26%) are under one year of age. Life expectancy was not long. Only 55 (19.5%) are age 65 years or more. The major causes of adult deaths were Consumption or Tuberculosis, Old Age, and Heart Disease/Failure. A few tragedies are recorded: 3 drowned, 3 shot to death and 1 suicide.

The following list contains names not found in the Otsego cemetery records. It is possible that some may be buried in the Otsego cemetery because of their relationship to family members whose graves have been identified. These names are preceded with the symbol \*. It is possible that some grave markers have deteriorated with age or have been destroyed or stolen. People of the Catholic faith usually buried in St. Michael, Dayton, Albertville or Elk River.

Material in these township record books is handwritten, faded with age and often the penmanship style is difficult to read. It is recorded here as accurately as possible. Where an item is not clear it is displayed; ?, 1877?, Anajan?, or A ?. Because these books are old and fragile, it is not wise to permit handling them for further research and study.

Every effort has been made to include all available information, but very few entries contain all of the information listed below. Misspelled words and names are recorded as they appear in the books.
